

Quality, Learning and Standards Committee

Terms of Reference, Membership and Delegated Authority

1. To review the College experience of students at all stages of the learner journey, from pre-entry to exit.
2. To ensure Safeguarding arrangements within the College are rigorous and fully implemented through regular monitoring and review.
3. To review, monitor and approve the College Quality Strategy to the Governing Body.
4. To monitor teaching & learning, retention, achievement, success rates and destinations annually, benchmarking results against national averages where these are available.
5. To validate and recommend the College's Self Assessment report to the Governing Body.
6. To scrutinise performance against improvement targets, assessing progress against the College's Quality Improvement Plan.
7. To monitor curriculum development and innovation within the College.
8. To review, monitor and approve the College's Employer Engagement Strategy to the Governing Body.
9. To review, monitor and approve the College's Learning Systems and Resources Strategy to the Governing Body.
10. To review and monitor the College's Single Equality Scheme and action plan.

Proposed Delegated Authority

Authority to be delegated by the Governing Body when resolved to be required.

Proposed Membership

The Committee to consist of 9 nominated members.

Quorum

The quorum for the Committee to be set at 4 members.

Clerk

The Clerk to the Corporation shall act as Clerk to the Committee.
